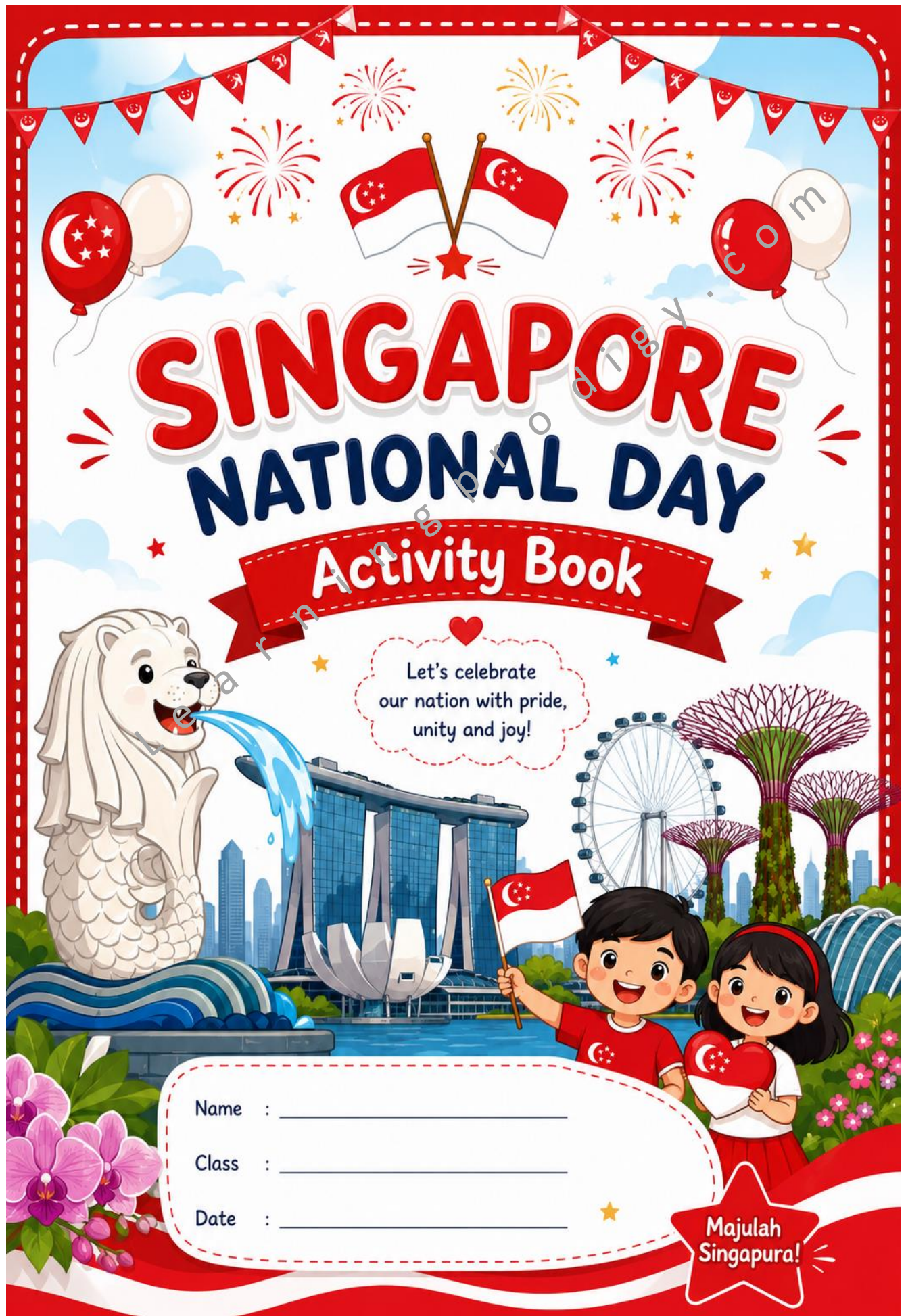






Read the Passage Carefully

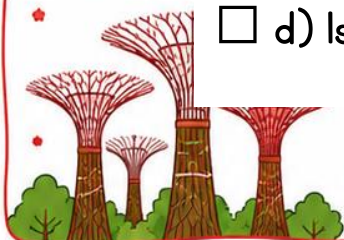
As young Singaporeans, we can show our love for our country by respecting others, keeping our surroundings clean, studying hard, and helping our community.
