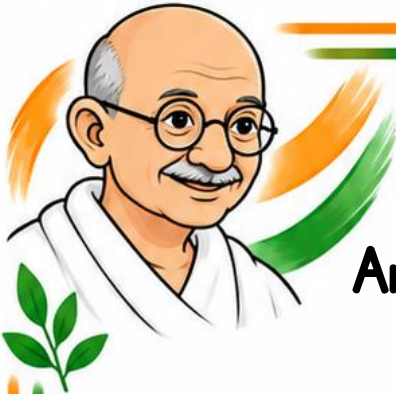




An Essay on Gandhi Jayanti

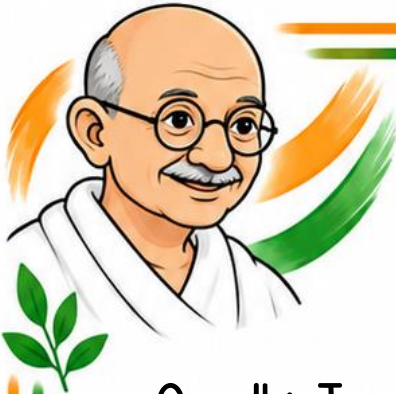
